

# GRAND SUMMIT BOER GOAT SHOW & SALE

## Sale Rules and Entry Information (read carefully)

1. All animals must have registration paper to sell with the exception of commercial animals.
2. All animals must be healthy with no visible signs of pinkeye, CL abscesses, foot rot or any other health problems. Animals will be asked to leave the barn if not healthy. A copy of a health paper must accompany each goat entered in the sale.
3. Terms of the sale are cash.
4. All goats sold will be charged 8% commission. Sellers have the option of placing a reserve bid, but this must be done before the animals enter the sale ring. All reserve bid no sales will be assessed an 8% commission charge.
5. No consignor will be permitted more goats in their pens or on the grounds than has been consigned to the show and/or sale. No sifted goats are to be sold on the premises.
6. Every buck and does sold will be guaranteed as a breeder if properly handled. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to return the non-breeder in acceptable breeding condition. The seller after a fair trial and the animal is found to be a non-breeder shall have the privileged of replacing the buck or doe with one of equal value or refund money.
7. Ownership changes hands when the goats are sold in the ring and legally paid for.
8. Grand Summit Boer Goat Show & Sale nor sale management assumes no financial liability for the safety of all entries.
9. All goats must be in the pens on Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup>. All sale animals will be paint branded as soon as possible.

    - iii. Doe kids in the order of show class placing
  - d. Champion FullBlood Bucks
    - i. Aged Bucks in the order of show class placing
    - ii. Yearling Bucks in the order of show class placing
    - iii. Buck Kids in the order of show class placing
  - e. Commercial Bucks
  - f. Commercial Does
11. **Non-refundable entry fees are \$10 per head on animals for sale (does not include show entry fee).** All entries are due (postmarked) August 20<sup>th</sup> and will be subject to approval by the Sale Committee. Entry fees will be refunded if entry is not accepted by the Sale Committee. Emailed entries are accepted, if check for fees is sent by mail postmarked by August 20<sup>th</sup> for show and sale book.
12. No sale/sold animals will be loaded to leave the premises until the end of the sale.
